- You must have been enrolled and <u>completed</u> projects in 4-H at least four years including the last 4-H year.
- You must have <u>completed</u> projects and <u>exhibited</u> them at the Twin Falls County Fair during at least two of the last four years immediately preceding your year of graduation.
- You must be a senior and currently enrolled in high school or an equivalent program.
- You must have an equivalent cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Applications must be received by the Extension Office by **March 29, 2024**. There will be no exceptions.
